# Concerns

- Watching inappropriate content such as:

- The risks of “Livestreaming”
- “Elsagate” and the editing of children’s content



# Advice on managing YouTube

- Have a “shared family account” so you can track what is being viewed
- Each computer/device can have “Restricted Mode” turned on
- Talk with your children about what they watch
- Monitor their content

- Common Sense Media

- PEGI will also identify why the game has been given that rating
- These help you make judgements on what you are comfortable with your children playing

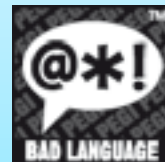

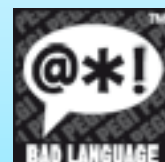

# Concerns

- Accessing of inappropriate content such as:
  - Pornography
  - Violence
  - Swearing
  - Self Harm & Suicide
- Unmonitored contact with others
- Excessive use of technology

# OurPact

An application for parents & carers



Allows you to:

- Schedule times children can use their devices
- Block or time restrict certain apps
- Block or time restrict texting
- Block or time restrict internet use
- Give children a "technology allowance"

# Internet Provider Support

- All major Internet Service Providers have the facility to block adult content
- All major phone networks now do the same
- This system is not full-proof but is very effective



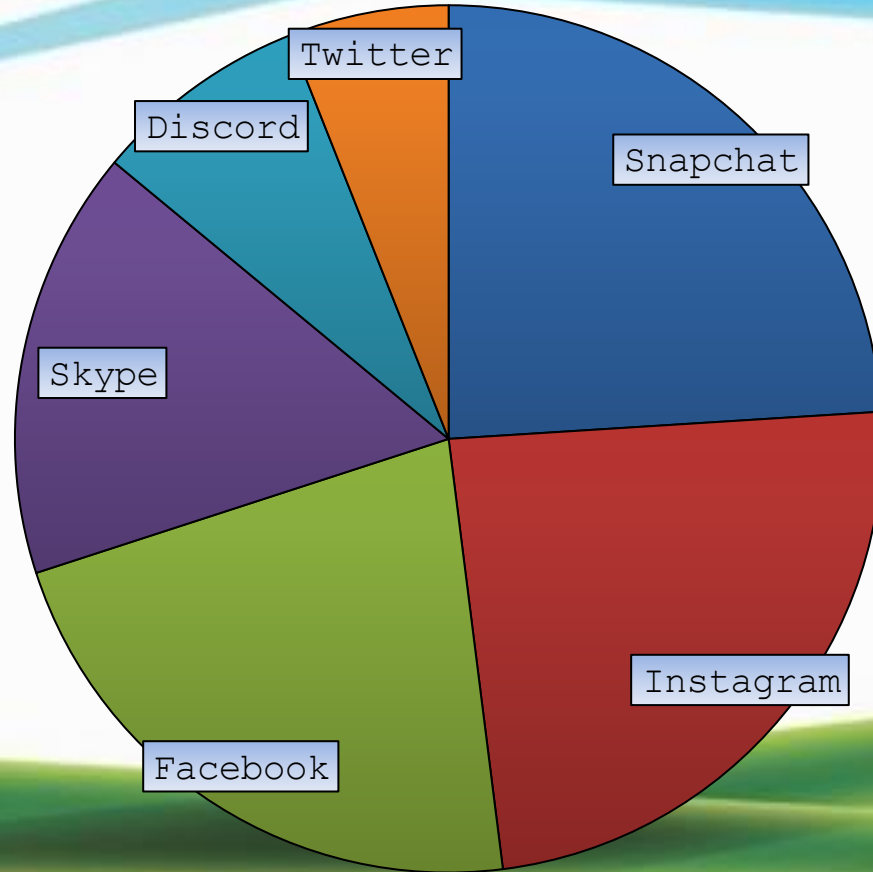

- Aimed at Gamers
- Allows text based messages
- Allows video calling
- Very similar to Whatapp and Facebook Messenger
