

Maths

This term pupils will focus on number. This will include: place value, reading and writing numbers; counting in multiples; comparing numbers using more than, less than and equal to. Pupils will then focus on adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

In term 1 pupils will focus on dance. This will be broken down into jumping, rolling and symmetrical movement to music. In term 2 pupils will focus on gymnastics and sequencing.

RE

Pupils will learn about what Christians believe. They will learn about who Christians believed made the world and the process behind this. Pupils will be given the opportunity to explore the Bible and creation stories from this. They will learn key stories from the bible including the nativity story at Christmas time. Pupils will also learn why these stories are considered special and how modern day Christians try to apply these to their everyday living to care for others and make the world a better place.

English

This term pupils will be looking at a story called 'The Dinosaur that Pooped the Bed'. There will then be an opportunity for pupils to write their own story about having a pet dinosaur, and reflection time to think about whether the dinosaur would be helpful. After half term pupils are focusing on information texts. Pupils will discover the features of information texts and put these into their very own information text.

Pupils will discuss what kindness means to them and how they show they are kind to others. Pupils will be discussing bullying, what this is, how it can affect people and what to do if they feel they are being bullied. They will then move onto discussing safety in the household.

Music

To understand and take part in a basic call and response sequence using a set beat. This will start off as a simple one word call and response and progress into a series of more complicated rhythms and rhymes. This will also study tempo and rhythm including opportunities for the pupils to choose and play a percussion instrument with a partner.

Science

Pupils are focusing on understanding and using electricity. This includes how to make different types of simple circuits, how electronic devices have changed over history and how electricity was discovered. Pupils will also be given the opportunity to practise their life skills by making cups of tea and using a microwave. After half term the focus will be on forces and motion. This will be taught with some scientific enquiry.

Topic

The topic for the autumn term is dinosaurs. Pupils will focus on the key vocabulary before moving onto the different species of dinosaur. Pupils will then understand what dinosaurs ate, the differences between carnivores and herbivores and what time periods they were alive. In term 2, pupils will be studying celebrations. This will involve discussions on when people celebrate and different celebrations from around the world.
