Science Mr Hughes	<p>This term we will be learning about elements, mixtures and compounds. The pupils will be doing a range of experiments to explore their uses as well as learning new terminology. Arts award Miss Price	<p>This term pupils will participate in a range of drama activities, designed for them to learn and develop key drama skills such as miming, freeze frames, characterisation, prop work, designing scenery and backdrops, designing costumes, directing, vocal techniques, rehearsal and performance skills.
