English Miss Cooper	During online learning this term the theme will be Detectives. Pupils will develop their skimming and scanning skills to find facts. They will understand the importance of providing evidence and will develop their inference skills. Maths Mrs Brown	This term activities will be set on MyMaths about Statistics. This will involve understanding different ways of representing data using the relevant vocabulary. Tasks will be set at individual levels and will include interpreting and presenting data using appropriate graphical methods, including bar charts and time graphs. Pupils will solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in bar charts, pictograms, tables and other graphs. Science Mr Goodchild	This term we will be finishing the work on pollution of the land, water and atmosphere and then move on to a chemistry topic which looks at the evolution of our atmosphere and global warming. We will start by looking at what gases were in the atmosphere of the early earth billions of years ago and then move on to look at what caused the gases in this atmosphere to change into those that we have today. In weeks 3, 4 and 5, pupils will be learning about line and pattern by completing the tasks I will set on Google Drive each week.
