<p>English <b>Mr Foulkes</b></p>	<p>This term we will be looking into heroism, both real-life heroes (such as NHS workers) and Super Heroes. There are a range of tasks available on the English Homework Menu for Term 5. The aim of this scheme of work is to use creativity, imagination and fantasy, and then apply this to a range of writing tasks. Pupils should aim to use a range of vocabulary that is relevant to heroism when completing the writing tasks. There are also opportunities to discuss some of the ideas together as a family, or put their ideas into a poem format. <p>Maths <b>Mrs Brown</b></p>	<p>This term activities will be set on MyMaths about Statistics. This will involve understanding different ways of representing data using the relevant vocabulary. Tasks will be set at individual levels and will include interpreting and presenting data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. Pupils will answer questions about totalling and comparing data and solve one-step and two-step questions using information presented in scaled bar charts and pictograms and tables. <p>Science <b>Mr Foulkes</b></p>	<p>This term we will be finishing the work on pollution of the land, water and atmosphere and then move on to a chemistry topic which looks at the evolution of our atmosphere and global warming. We will start by looking at what gases were in the atmosphere of the early earth billions of years ago and then move on to look at what caused the gases in this atmosphere to change into those that we have today. Finally we will explore what global warming is and how we think the changes humans are making to the atmosphere are causing this to happen.</p>	<p>Atmosphere Global Warming Pollution Climate Photosynthesis</p>
<p>DT <b>Miss Attenborough</b></p>	<p>Designers are often inspired by historic design movements e.g. Art Nouveau, Arts and Crafts, Art Deco etc. This term you will be looking at design movements and make use of things that have been designed before, and even clever things that exist in nature. You will be completing a research, design and make project. 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Art Miss Foster	During online learning this term pupils will be exploring two of the elements of art and design; line and pattern. These elements are the fundamental skills that underpin all activities within art and design. Each week I will be setting an activity made up of 2 or more tasks relating to either line or pattern for pupils to complete at home. PE and Games Mr Hunt	During online learning this term, pupils can participate in cricket tasks and challenges which can be carried out in the home. Pupils will be focusing on key skills such as catching, throwing, fielding, bowling and batting. They will then transfer these into a range of different cricket challenges and games over the weeks. A shorter activity is also available for those who may prefer this, as well as a non-internet option which is a comprehension activity, with a fact sheet and some differentiated questions. 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Life Skills <b>Mr Bentley</b>	As part of Life Skills we will be learning about travel. We will be using the internet to explore places in the United Kingdom and the wider world that we could visit in the future. We will look at different types of holidays that people could experience including camping and adventure holidays, city breaks and beach holidays. Music <b>Mrs Lea</b>	During this term of home learning, lessons will be based on designing, making and playing musical instruments. Pupils will also have the opportunity to create a short story or comic strip about their Superhero. I will also set a short acting activity each week; relating to the Superhero topic.
