




As a class, we went through our Good to be Green system and enjoyed talking about how we can make good choices!



Another super week for 2H! They thoroughly enjoyed Computing this week where they have been learning about videoing different shots. We have actors and producers in the making!


Well done to Miley for showing care and consideration towards her friends.




Ahoy There!!

A morning at Brewers Fayre and lots of 'Shivering our Timbers' and 'Battening down the Hatches' on our Forest School Pirate Ship!






Key Stage 3

3E had a fabulous time in PSD talking about changes to the body. In food we made macaroni cheese, which smelt delicious!




In drama, this week, we went back in time to the Vikings era. Luckily, no one fell off the long boat on the way there!

In preparation for our shopping trips to Morrisons we have been acting out scenarios to help us ask for what we might need in the shop.




There were definitely dinosaurs around the school somewhere during Drama!


3L

In preparation for our DT project, we explored the equipment we will need to make textiles. We identified the bobbin, pinking shears and stitch rippers.








Ed is also our House Point winner this week, so Congratulations Ed!!




In RE this week we've been learning about the symbols for the six main world religions. We learnt that the symbol for Hinduism is called the 'Aum', which most of us recognised from meditation.


